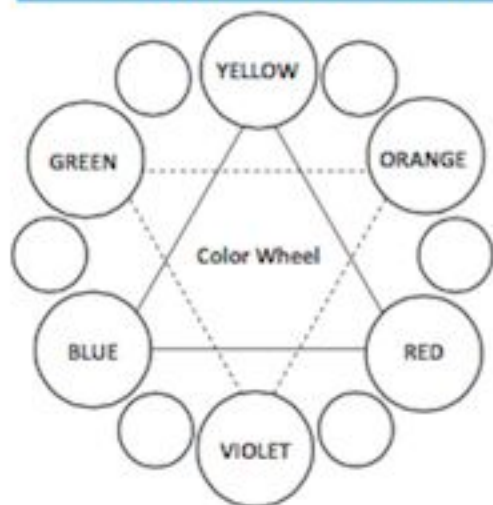




# What Will I Learn in Second & Third Grade Art?



I can discover the intermediate colors and use them when I create art.

**Primary colors:** Red, Yellow, Blue

**Secondary colors:** Orange, Green, Violet

**Intermediate colors:** Red-orange, Red-violet, Blue-green, Blue-violet, Yellow-green, Yellow-orange

**Neutral colors:** Black, White, Gray, Brown

If I add **WHITE** to a color, it will become lighter.

This is called a **tint**.

If I add **BLACK** to a color, it will become darker.

This is called a **shade**.

I can identify 3D forms.
